- K Provides for parental participation interventions.**
- K Establishes eligibility criteria for AIS.**
- K Contains AIS record to show eligibility, diagnosis, and interventions, and services.**
- K Houses parental communications for beginning AIS, progress reports, continuing and/or ending AIS with batch printing capability with mailing labels for all students and those served in AIS.**
- K Provides a data-based process for biennial revision of district AIS plan.**
- K Communicate in student's native language.**

- K Provides for descriptions of instructional strategies.**
- K Provides for identification and description of district assessments to determine AIS eligibility and/or diagnosis.**
- K References State learning standards and performance indicators with codes.**
- K Provides printable reports for analysis.**
- K Archives student AIS records.**
- K Provides performance profile of testing results for All students.**
- K Provides for Regents exam component retesting.**
- K Provides 9th grade cohort reporting.**
